

Final Exam Information for Students

1. Your computerized final Exam for Math 055, Pre-College Algebra V, CRN 6004 will be administered on Wednesday, August 5, 2020.
2. The exam period is 75 minutes in length. Be sure to arrive promptly to maximize the amount of time you will have to complete the exam. If you arrive late, you may not be permitted to stay beyond the original 75-minute testing window.
3. Bring the following items to the testing room with you:
 - Pencil and eraser
 - A scientific calculator, if you are enrolled in Math 022, Math 033, Math 044, or Math 055
Note: Math 008 students may not use a calculator.
Note: Math 022, 033, 044, and 055 students **may not use a graphing calculator.**
 - Cell phones and smart watches must be silenced and put away the entire time you're taking the exam.
 - This is a closed-book, closed notes exam. Students may not access any other websites or applications while taking their final exam.
4. If you usually save your MyLabsPlus username and password to a home computer, make sure that you have these for the day of your exam.
5. Log in to your MyLabsPlus account as soon as you arrive to the computer lab, open the Final Exam, and wait for your instructor to type in the exam password for you.
6. As you complete each problem, place your scratch work on the paper provided, then type your answer into the computer. Problems will be marked wrong if you do not enter the answers correctly. So, be sure to follow the directions describing how you must enter each answer. You will be graded only on the answer typed into MyLabsPlus. As you work through the exam, you may skip problems and return to them later.
7. When you feel you have completed all of the problems to the best of your ability, click the "Submit" button. Your exam score will then appear on the screen.
8. When you're ready to leave the testing room, log out of your MyLabsPlus account and hand in all of your scrap paper. You may not take anything with you that you didn't have when you entered the room.
9. If your final grade in the course is a D or F, consult with your academic advisor or a counselor about changing your course schedule to retake the course in the next term. Your instructor is also available to answer any questions.
